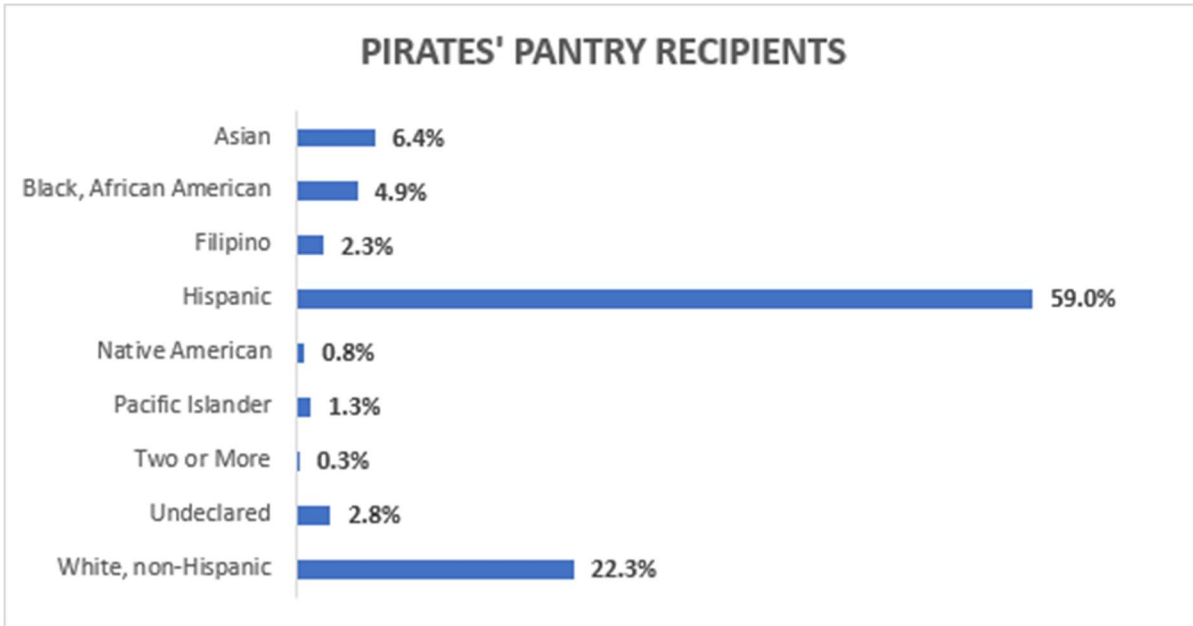


# MJC Just the Facts – Pirates’ Pantry
