Learning Online is...

Different from a traditional classroom course in format only. Online courses are just as challenging and interesting as other courses you might take at MJC. They carry full college credit that may be applied to MJC graduation or university transfer. Plus, you register for an online course as you would for any MJC course.

If you can answer "Yes" to all these questions, you are ready to take an online class.

- Do you have experience with the use of web "browsers"?
- Are you a self-motivated, disciplined, and independent learner?
- Do you have good reading and problem-solving skills?
- Do you have regular access to a computer with a reliable Internet connection?
- Are you comfortable using a word-processing application like Microsoft Word?
- Are you comfortable with the concept of creating and using file "attachments"?

Blackboard™ Learning System

We offer instruction online using the Blackboard™ Learning System, a comprehensive web-based instruction system used by colleges and universities around the globe. The Blackboard Learning System is a virtual campus where you submit your assignments, chat with instructors and peers, and, of course, learn.

Hybrid Courses

A small number of courses each semester are offered as "Hybrid" courses. These courses are structured as Internet/traditional courses, and require both classroom and online participation.

How Online Learning Works

Course curriculum is posted on the Blackboard Learning System, which is accessible through <http://www.mjc.edu>. Courses are available around the clock, making it possible to fit them into your schedule when it's convenient for you. However, online courses take the same total amount of time as on-campus courses, and their activities are based on deadlines, so careful time management is required in order to be successful.

You may interact with your instructor and classmates using tools such as email, online presentations, discussion boards, assignment tools and assessment tools. In addition, most online instructors are available to meet on campus during posted office hours, virtual chat office hours or by telephone.

How to add an online class if you are on a wait list:

- 1) On the first day of the class, submit an Electronic Add Card at: <http://www.mjc.edu>. Select PiratesNet icon then click on PiratesNet for Current Students. Once you have logged in, click on Electronic Add Card Request (For Online Classes).
- 2) When you have submitted the card, the instructor will contact you by email with instructions on how to add the class if you have been accepted for the course.

How to add an online class if you are NOT on a wait list:

Registration for MJC online classes is available for students that have already submitted an MJC application. If you have not submitted an MJC application, go to <http://www.mjc.edu> and apply for admission to MJC. Once you have applied, follow the directions below. If you already have an application on file, follow the directions below. On the first day of the class, submit an Electronic Add Card at <http://www.mjc.edu>. Select the PiratesNet icon, then click on PiratesNet for Current Students. Once you have logged in, click on Electronic Add Card Request (for Online classes).

- 1) After you have submitted the add card, the instructor will contact you by email with instructions either on how to add the class, if space is available, or that no space is available in the class.
- 2) After the deadline to add a class you must get the Dean's signature. For an online class print the authorization and have the Dean sign it. For special accommodations, contact Admissions at 209-575-6853.

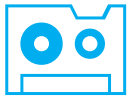

Video Based Courses

What is a Video-Based course?

Video-based courses are created from recorded lectures delivered in an on-campus class. The lectures can then be watched via high speed Internet connection (24/7), cable television, VHS tapes, or DVD's. The lectures you watch in a video-based course are usually from a previous semester. The goal is to provide the same experience you would have in an on-campus class with the advantage of being able to pause, rewind, and forward the lectures. Images and lecture notes are linked and can be printed. Video tutorials also provide access to help on specific topics.

Video-based courses carry full college credit that may be applied to MJC graduation. You can register for a video-based course in the same way you can register for any course at MJC. The enrollment fee is the same as it is for a traditional classroom course, and you pay your fees following registration.

Most of the video-based courses require that you come on campus during weekends for exams. However, other arrangements can be made if you have time conflicts. You are expected to e-mail the instructor each week summarizing your activities in the course. You should plan on spending as much time watching the lectures and doing the homework that you would for an on-campus class.

- by watching a streaming video* during your scheduled class time at <http://www.mjc.edu/mjcvideo> (Microsoft Media Player required).
- by watching VHS tapes available at the Reserve Desk in the East Campus Library.
- by purchasing a DVD set of the lectures at the MJC bookstore.

* If your computer has high-speed Internet access.

- 1) Register for the video-based course using Internet Registration, Telephone Registration, or visit the Admissions Office.

- 4) Click on the link for the current semester schedule and click on each week for links to the lectures, board presentations, and homework assignments.

What is a Telecourse?

Telecourses are MJC courses viewed on television, usually on video/DVDs. They carry full college credit that may be applied to MJC graduation. You register for a telecourse using Internet Registration or Touchtone Registration as you would for any MJC course. The enrollment fee is the same as it is for a traditional classroom course, and you will pay your fees following registration.

You will receive your course syllabus and other course materials via the mail. Students who succeed in telecourses are self-motivated, independent learners. It's in your best interest to review telecourse requirements prior to enrolling.

Most telecourses have several mandatory meetings on campus, and instructors will communicate with you via the mail.

Students may check out telecourse tapes for the semester. Contact the Library Reserve Counter at (209) 575-6437 for more information on checking out video/DVDs.

How to Take a Telecourse

- 1) Register for the Telecourse using Internet Registration or Telephone Registration.
- 2) Make sure your current mailing address is on file at the Records Office.
- 3) Watch the mail for your course information packet which will be mailed to you directly.
- 4) Attend an on-campus Orientation if required.
- 5) View your video/DVD using one of the methods in the box above.
